The Dorset Leagues

The DSRPA have been running airgun leagues since the early 1980's, the other disciplines were added either as a belated response to the pistol ban of 1996/7, or at the request of a participating club. As all leagues follow a similar format preliminary details are now condensed into one publication.

To keep costs to reasonable levels the leagues are run on a self scoring basis, although you may return shot cards if you prefer, or if you are unable to get an independent scorer. Competitors will be allocated divisions based on averages in the previous season's Dorset leagues, or on submitted averages. Division sizes will be dependant on the number of entries, but will normally be about eight competitors per division. Medals will be issued to first place in each division only. Each discipline comprises thirty shots per round, two rounds per month, for a total of eight rounds. You may start as soon as you receive the stickers, and you may shoot as far in advance as you wish.

COURSE OF FIRE

Ten Metre pistol and rifle shot under ISSF Rules. Each round will consist of five shots on each of six of the appropriate Air 2/3/4 targets.

Six Yard pistol and rifle shot under NSRA Rules. Each round will consist of five shots on each of six of the appropriate Air 7/8 targets.

Lightweight Sport Rifle

Open to .22 rimfire and air/CO² rifles as defined under Section 8 of the NSRA Rules. Any sights except laser. Each round will consist of five shots on each of six PL14 targets shot at twenty yards..

Gallery Rifle (C-F)

Open to any gallery rifle as defined under NRA Rules. Any sights except laser. Each round will consist of five shots on each of six PL15 targets shot at twenty yards.

20 Yard Pistol

Open to .22 longarm and air/CO² pistols, open sights only. Each round will consist of ten shots on each of three PL15 targets shot at twenty yards in the standing position.

Benchrest Rifle

Open to .22 rimfire and air/CO² rifles as defined under Section 8 of the NSRA Rules. Any sights except laser. Each round will consist of ten shots on each of three BR15/17 2010 or 2510 targets shot at the appropriate distance.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are £2.50 per individual entry per discipline. Team of three entries are shot concurrently and are £3.00 per team (i.e. £1.00 per person). Team members must have entered as an individual.

If a competitor entered the leagues the previous season, then that average should be used. In all other cases you will need the most recent average. All previous seasons results/averages can be downloaded from www.dsrpa.co.uk as a pdf file.

CLOSING DATE

Closing date for entries is Saturday 24th March; but stickers will be issued immediately upon receipt of the completed entry form, so the sooner you return the form the sooner you can start. Score Sheets, etc. will be forwarded to you shortly after the closing date. The first two rounds will be due by the last Saturday in April, i.e. the 28th.

Entry forms may be returned as e-mail attachments, or printed and returned by post. Entry fees may be paid by posting a cheque, or alternatively by bank transfer, please ask if you require our details.

SCORING

Score sheets will be supplied in Excel format if you are returning scores by e-mail, printed copy if you are returning by Royal Mail. Open Office, the free open source software suite, will open and save Excel files; there may be discrepancies in layout but generally it will present no problems.

RESULTS

As with shot score returns the league results may be issued either by e-mail (in pdf format), or a printed copy by post, the choice is yours. Providing clubs/competitors return scores on time I normally expect to issue results within three to four days.

Competitors should be made aware that the league results will be published online, either by the DSRPA or by one of the many Clubs who enter the leagues, and by entering you are deemed to be giving permission for your name to be published.
